THE FEE INCLUDES:

2 nights stay, at least 6' of table space, lodging (dorm-style, bottom bunks & showers), (4) meals (2 brunches & 2 dinners).

Brunches: a variety of food options

Sweet Tea/Lemonade/Water provided throughout the days and at meals

Wifi & 24 hour access to your project space inside the same facility as your lodging.

WHAT TO BRING:

Bedding (twin), towels, and toiletries.

You may bring drinks and snacks with you. There is a kitchen w/2 fridges adjacent to our work space.

Your machines, cords, materials - you can bring extra small tables and your own chair if you like. (Let us know if you are bringing anything bigger than a TV tray table so we can be sure to make room)

Space is limited to 20 and will fill up fast - we hope you can join us!

****If you would like to stay additional nights* Cost is \$10 per night Sunday through Wednesday (8th-11th) - meals/drinks will not be provided these days but there will be kitchen amenities available for your shared convenience.***

To Note - A local business has agreed to provide on site access/assistance for some maker items/equipment under their supervision - commercial heat press, mug press, cap press, Cricut Maker, some hand tools & metal stamps for jewelry making/leather crafting. Let us know if there is something in particular you might need (glue guns, paint brushes, wood blanks, decals - we may be able to have them waiting for you). We will update the list as more information becomes available.

COVID Guidelines

Our goal is to get campers back to camp as safely and quickly as possible whatever that might look like as far as Covid guidelines are concerned. Hilltop follows all state and local mandates as they pertain to youth camps.

Just as Hilltop does for all campers during summer sessions, there will be a health/temp check as soon as you get to camp (no-touch thermometers).

If your temp is 100 or over you will not be allowed to stay.

Hilltop will have disinfecting done and disinfect common areas daily.

Disinfectant spray is also available in bathroom areas for your own use.

Hand sanitizer will be available.

Please wear a mask if mandated at that time - we have a few on hand but please bring your own if you have one.

For meals - if mandated - we will wear masks and gloves (at least on serving hands).

Lodging will be in the Campbell Complex.
