FROM THE DIRECTOR'S DESK

Over the past few years serving here at Hilltop I have seen God moving in amazing ways. This year again brings so much that I am thankful for. We were given the opportunity this summer to purchase an additional 28 acres of land. In August we closed on the new property that runs along the west side of camp and financed the purchase at 0% interest for 12 months. Our goal being to raise the funds for the property within the first year. **To help us reach this goal we have a donor that has issued a challenge for us to match his donation of \$50,000. Meaning that if we raise \$50,000 by the end of the year, we will have a total of \$100,000 towards the land purchase.** That will leave only \$17,000 remaining to completely pay for the property. The great news is that since we announced the matching challenge at the celebration dinner, **we have already raised \$27,000** for the property! God is Awesome! The season has changed, the time has changed, and we have some changes coming up at camp! The kitchen, slop, and coffee/drink area are getting much needed repairs & upgrade!

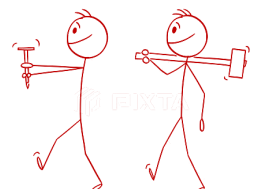
If you like to help with demolition work, painting, carpentry, plumbing or if you're into organizing or can just hold or carry things :) this is the service project for you because it has it all!

The kitchen & dining hall have been well loved over the years. The wood cabinets are starting to breakdown and repairs are no longer an option on some equipment and in some areas where we need to contain water. The dining hall will be the longest standing building in the 100th year plan ahead for camp. We need it in tip top shape to serve all of our campers and visitors for the long haul. The plan is to get all of the wood out of the kitchen, install a dedicated hand wash station, bring in a double fryer and double oven, update the fire suppression system over the cooking surfaces, repair/repaint the floor, paint the walls, repair/paint the ceiling, and a few other odd and end items. This space needs to be functional to help us meet the needs of our growing summer camps and events!
