## Registration

If you already have a Hilltop account, great, be sure you use that one, you can add new campers to an existing account. **If you do not remember your account information, please call the office instead of creating a new account.** If you do not have an account, go to our website and follow the prompts to create an account. Please complete all forms BEFORE check-in at camp. Waivers must be signed by the camper's parent/guardian to be allowed to participate in adventure activities. *Printable registration forms are available on our website [www.hilltopchristiancamp.com](http://www.hilltopchristiancamp.com).*

## Camp Session Minimum Tuition Deposit

Each session requires a tuition deposit to secure your camper's desired session. Your camper is not registered for camp until the tuition deposit has been paid. *For more information regarding this deposit see 'Cancellations/Refunds'.*

## Camper Payments

When registering, you must at least pay the tuition deposit to reserve your desired camp session. If no deposit is made, your spot is not confirmed/reserved. You may pay with credit card (online or over the phone), check, or money order. We ask that all camper's balances be paid in full prior to arriving to camp for the session. You can log back into your account to make payments for camp sessions. You have the option to leave money on your camper's account to use at the camp store/canteen. Any remaining money not spent by the end of the camp week will be put toward camp's mission.

## Cancellations/Refunds

If you cancel your registration 4 weeks or more before the session start date, any money paid can be refunded including the tuition deposit. From 4 weeks to 15 days within sessions start date, all money except the minimum tuition deposit can be refunded. If registration is canceled within 14 days of the session start date, no money will be refunded. *Refunds will not be made for campers departing a camp session early.*

## Church Scholarships

Check with your church to see if they provide scholarship assistance for Hilltop summer camp tuition. Your church determines the amount/type of financial assistance they provide. The codes for financial assistance are given out by the church. *It is best to get this code before you begin the registration process.*

## Food Allergies

Due to the small percentage of campers with food allergies in comparison to the entire camp population, some food allergies are difficult to accommodate. The kitchen staff are willing to help but are not able to accommodate all allergies on their own. If you have concerns about your child's meals, please contact the camp in advance so that you can get a weekly menu for you to plan supplemental meals according to your child's dietary requirements. We are happy to keep allergy free meals for your child in our refrigerator/freezer and prep them for your child at mealtimes.

## Safety/Security

We realize that you are entrusting the camp staff, volunteers, and faculty with your precious child(ren). We strive to provide a safe, distraction free environment. Every staff, volunteer, and faculty who is 18yrs old and older must complete a background check. Our staff are certified in First-Aid, CPR, Lifeguard, ServSafe, etc. Hilltop also has security cameras in many places around camp as well as the gated entrance to ensure the safety of campers and to know who is coming and going from camp. No visitors are permitted during the camp week - any exceptions are at the discretion of the dean and camp director.

## Camp Mail
