TORNADO DAMAGE UPDATE

On the evening of Thursday June 17, Hilltop Christian Camp was impacted by an EF-1 tornado that ripped through the camp. We are incredibly thankful that there were no campers on site at the time and that all of our staff were safe.



The days that followed were a powerful reminder of our incredible community. From June 18–20, more than 100 volunteers came to camp to help clear trees, remove debris, and begin the long process of getting camp back in shape. Their hard work and willingness to serve made it possible for us to open camp back up to campers on Sunday, June 21.

While so much was accomplished in those few days, there is still a great deal of clean up ahead. Many trees still need to be cleared as this will continue to be an important project in the months ahead.

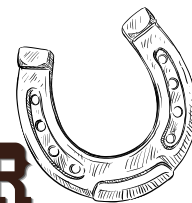
